



INFORMATION ABOUT VERIZON'S PROPOSED 158 FOOT CELL TOWER IN THE HEART OF POWELL BUTTE RANCH LAND

You can help protect our community!

- Verizon has leased land in the center of Powell Butte's Exclusive Farm Use (EFU) area for a new cell phone tower.
- The cell tower is a lattice structure **158 feet tall**, approximately **14 stories**.
- The site of the tower is in a flat, low cultivated field and would be visible from **all over** Powell Butte. There are no trees or structures to block the view of the tower.
- **THE TOWER WOULD DESTROY LOCAL VIEWS, LOWER LAND VALUES, AND CHANGE THE CHARACTER OF OUR COMMUNITY.**
- The huge lattice structure could harm migratory and resident birds that use Houston Lake, just 2 miles away, and the adjacent "Tom's Pond".
- Verizon is not supposed to be able to put a tower on Exclusive farmland if there is non-EFU land it can use.
- If one cell tower is allowed, others can't be far behind.
